

### Sports Meet – SPIRIT 2017

<b>Summary</b>	<p>Spirit 2017, the Annual Intra college Sports meet at RDIAS is a penultimate event that provides facilities and opportunities for students to participate in sports. It adds value to the work of oneself and others and helps to deliver development goals through recreation and contribute to a wide array of aspirations, leisure, health and education. Thus, this intramural competition was organized to reduce stress, enhance the leadership quality and also celebrate the importance of sports.</p> <p>The sports meet started with a Cricket Tournament having knocked out matches, semi-finals and finals held among 8 teams participated.
