Aim of the Event	<p>It is rightly said that “Attitude is everything”! Having the right attitude can make the difference between success and failure. It doesn't matter if you're dealing with the business world or your own family; the right attitude counts, and a good leader not only displays the right attitude at all times, he does his best to encourage the right attitude in others as well.</p> <p>This lecture focused on the importance of carrying the right attitude, particularly to the place of interview. Which is why this session was organized for the students of MBA II, if the roots are strong the tree would automatically bear delicious fruit.</p>

<p>Event Description:</p>	<p>This session started with a discussion on how students should behave & carry themselves in an interview and a group discussion. Students were told that the first 20 seconds were the most crucial in an interview. An interviewee should prepare himself /herself for the most likely questions in the interview like- "Tell me some thing about yourself?".</p> <p>It was also told that according to a study in U.S.A, 50% of first impression is created by body language and appearance. In a Group Discussion a person should emphasize on communication skills, articulation, body language, opening remarks, analytical skills, emotional control & decisiveness.</p> <p>All students have heard about this topic many times but this lecture succeeded in maintaining and sustaining the interest of students!</p>
