Description of the event	<p>With her years of rich experience, Ms. Raut, in recruiting for various companies, shared the insights of the industry expectations. Starting with the requirements of corporate world, she asked some students to introduce themselves with their hobbies. After that she explained the importance of hobbies during their interview. She explained that the name of institute may matter but up to some extent. What matters most is attitude.</p> <p>Madam talked about unlimited opportunities available with the technological changes or revolution. She also quoted the example of acquiring whatsapp by facebook. She emphasized on product innovation which plays a vital role in the success of any organisation. During an interview, communication skills in the form of body language, intention is very important. If any student is not comfortable with communication skills, he/she must undergo a metamorphosis himself/herself during these two years.</p> <p>Madam said, by her experience, that the most important thing interviewer look in candidate is the attitude, intention to learn, confidence, body language, eye contact, potential, etc. she discussed about the “Fire in the Belly”. It means how much one is ready to learn new things. Think but convert it into action also otherwise it has no meaning to think.</p> <p>With such value addition, students came forward with the queries raised by the interviewers in their interviews.
