Summary	<p>An industry visit to National Dairy Research Institute was organized for students of BBA. Around 38 students and 2 faculty members visited the institute. The institute has organized an informative session for the students where they were introduced to the R&D programs initiated by the NDRI to better serve the nation in terms of food security, employment generation, poverty alleviation and economic prosperity</p> <p>Further, students visited cattle yard and witnessed the different breeds of cattle and various operations meant for them. Students have also seen the process of sensors, controlling animals’ diet and automated milking process through machines. Understanding the manufacturing and packaging process of clarified butter, cheese, milk cake, milk powder was also a part of the visit.
