Summary	<p>The monthly FDP on ³Financial Modeling and Intellectual Property Right was conducted by RDIAS. Financial model is simply a tool that is built in Excel to forecast a business financial performance into the future. The forecast is typically based on the company's historical performance, assumptions about the future, and requires preparing an income statement, balance sheet, cash flow statement. The output of a financial model is used for decision making and performing financial analysis, whether inside or outside of the company. One of the best ways to practice is to take a mature company's historical financials, build a flat-line model into the future, and calculate the net present value per share. This should compare closely to the current share price, or the target prices of equity research reports. Intellectual property rights refer to the general term for the assignment of property rights through patents, copyrights and trademarks. These property rights allow the holder to exercise a monopoly on the use of the item for a specified period.</p> <p>The aim of the FDP was to provide participants with the methodological skills necessary for them to carry out independent research in terms of financial modeling and IPR.
