Summary

RDIAS organized an industry visit for MBA-II semester students to make them aware about the industrial practices and processes followed in Dairy Industry. Students were taken for a visit to Gopaljee Dairy, Faridabad to provide them with the insight of manufacturing and processing of dairy products. Gopaljee Dairy has been operating in a masterly and flawless manner from past 35 years under the supervision of Mr. Gopaljee, Managing Director of Dairy.

The Dairy has two Plants in Faridabad. Students were organized in a single batch while visiting the plants. The facilitator showed around the students and informed them about the nitty gritty of the functioning of the plants.
