Summary

The MUN Society of Credence Club will be organizing a panel debate on 10th April 2019 for which the preliminary round to shortlist the students was held on 2nd April 2019.

Online registrations were taken by students and the topics were given to students in advance which were:

- 1. Can terror and talks, culture and sports go together?
- 2. Is neutrality of media in question? With special emphasis on Media Law

Each debater had to speak in favor or against it for two minutes. A panel of four members from the committee of the society was made for cross questioning after the participants had delivered their viewpoint.




