Summary	<p>Scenarios/ Case lets and role plays are examples of active and collaborative teaching techniques that are effective for the deep learning needed for students to be able to remember and apply concepts. Every manager comes across the situations which requires decision making or problem solving and so to make students aware about these situations, analyse the background and apply the decisions practically, HR Club organised the "Case study competition: Enactment- Theory to Practical" for the students of MBA- I and III semester on October 10, 2018. The aim was to have them practice application by making choices and refine their understanding of concepts and practice in their discipline. The students presented the case lets/ scenarios through role play which enabled students to assume roles and practice what to say and do in an organisational setting.</p> <p>The competition began with the anchors introducing the concept to all participants. The rules of the competition were further explained. There were 6 participant teams comprising 2-3 members in each team. These scenarios exposed students to common workplace issues that have significant HR implications and which managers and supervisors are often reluctant to confront. Through role playing, the students were able to develop deeper involvement and knowledge about the issues at hand.</p> <p>The participants were judged on the parameters of conceptual skills, present strategies, application of principles and quality of presentation by the Judge of the event- Dr. Tripti Toor, Associate Professor. Top 3 teams were awarded with the Cash Prize worth Rs.1500, Rs.1200 and Rs.900.
