Summary	<p>An Excursion trip to Agra was organised by Students Welfare Committee, RDIAS for two days i.e. 28-29 October 2018 for the students of BBA and MBA. A total of 4 staff members and 127 students of MBA & BBA went for the trip in three buses accompanied by a Tour Organizer.</p> <p>The aim of organizing this trip was to enjoy the stress free environment and gain new perspectives on the world. Students and Staff members assembled at RDIAS at 5:30 AM in the morning from where they boarded three A/C buses. On the first day, after reaching the hotel everyone had their meal and visited Taj Mahal. Taj Mahal at Agra, India, commissioned in 1632 by the Mughal emperor Shah Jahan to house the tomb of his favourite wife of three, Mumtaz Mahal, is one of the wonders of the world. DJ night was organised for the students on the same day from 8:00 pm onwards in the hotel.</p> <p>Second day started with the breakfast in the hotel itself. The students were then taken to Agra Fort .It was the main residence of the emperors of the Mughal Dynasty until 1638, when the capital was shifted from Agra to Delhi.</p> <p>The Agra fort is a UNESCO World Heritage site. After the beautiful experience in the Agra Fort, the students were taken to Fatehpur Sikri Fort. Fatehpur Sikri Fort, built during the second half of the 16th century by the Emperor Akbar, is listed among the World Heritage Sites. After that the students enjoyed their meal in a resort.</p> <p>The overall experience of the trip was mesmerizing. The students and staff had a great time enjoying the beauty of the monuments and Mughal architecture of the stunning imperial complex of Fatehpur Sikri Fort being a major tourist attraction.
