Summary	An Industrial Visit To "Amar Ujala (A Hindi-Language Daily Newspaper Published In India)", Noida was organized for the students of BBA-I-M-C. Facilitators Started With The Foundation And Estabilishment Of "Amar Ujala". The Students And Faculty Members Were Served With Delicious Snacks. The Students Unveiled The Presentation About The Company's Publishing Process, Plant Details , Quality And Quantity Measures. After That 18 Minutes Video Were Shown To The Students And Faculty Members About The Details Of Magazines And Newspaper Published By The "Amar Ujala", Starting With The History And Production Of Newspapers. The Video Also Revealed The Present Scenario Of Growing Industry And Their Influence Over The Market. After The Presentation The Students Asked Their Queries And The Facilitator Briefed Them About Amar Ujala's Production Unit And Printing Process. It Also Awared About How Carefully The News Designed, Framed, And Published In The Paper. Working Hour Of The Factory Was 3 Pm Onwords. Later On Students Were Shown The Machinery Room (Production Department), They Got Awared About The Process. Atlast The Students Were Takwn To Commercial Printing Devision, Which Was The Final Step Of Printing Process, Students Saw The Newspapers Printing.
