

Summary

RDIAS in collaboration with IIF College of Commerce and Management Studies, organised a webinar on *Atmanirbhar Bharat* Abhiyan: An Opportunity to change the Narrative from "Survival" to "Strength" on June 19, 2020 at 03:00 pm - 04:30 pm through Google Meet Platform wherein several academicians shared their knowledge.
